Re: April 4th Primary Election

Dear Puyallup Tribal Members/Voters:

In light of the Corona Virus ("COVID-19"), the Tribal Council is enacting the following social distancing measures in the upcoming primary election scheduled for April 4, 2020:

1. The Primary Election will be moved to Chief Leschi School located at 5625 52nd Street East, Puyallup, WA 98731. Voters will drive up to vote to protect all members from infection;
2. "No campaign" zones will be in effect and clearly demarcated, and no food will be allowed at the polling sites this year;
3. No walk-up voting will be allowed;
4. The polling site will be disinfected/sanitized regularly;
5. Hours for the election will remain from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.;
6. Elders living in assisted living facilities will receive drop-off ballots with stamped, return envelopes to be delivered by a designated member of the Election Board; and
7. No campaigning materials will be allowed in the voting zone including campaigning bumper stickers which will be covered up by Security.


